The Role

The Women's Team Physiotherapist will play a pivotal role within the Hampshire Cricket Science & Medicine Department, leading the delivery of physiotherapy services to the women's academy programme while providing key support to the professional women's squad across training and match environments. Working within a highly collaborative, multidisciplinary team—including Lead Physiotherapists, Strength & Conditioning Coaches, Sports Scientists, and Doctors—you will help optimise player performance, manage and reduce injury risk, and support long-term athlete development. This hands-on, varied role offers the opportunity to make a meaningful impact on both emerging and elite female athletes, with occasional support across the men's professional squad as required

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver high-quality physiotherapy support for Hampshire women's academy and pathway players.
- Provide additional support to the senior women's professional programme during the season and intermittently throughout the year, through collaboration with the Lead Women's Physiotherapist.
- Where necessary, and as directed by the Head of Science and Medicine, provide support across the men's programmes during high demand periods.
- Organise and conduct physical profiling for the women's Academy and Pathway players three times per year.
- Provide player availability updates in collaboration with Lead Physiotherapists, S&C staff, and the Chief Medical Officer.
- Work collaboratively within our multi-disciplinary Science & Medicine team.
- Create and implement injury prevention strategies aligned with best practice.
- In collaboration with other academy medical and coaching staff, contribute to Long-Term Athlete Development planning and delivery. Develop robust internal and external monitoring systems which best inform player management in current and future academy cricketers at Hampshire Cricket.
- Work closely with the Head of Talent Pathway and specialist academy coaching staff to supplement player development plans. This requires the ability to thrive within a broad multi-disciplinary team.
- Maintain high standards of medical governance and clinical practice.
- Actively participate in Science & Medicine reviews and ongoing professional development.

Essential

- HCPC and CSP registration.
- Undergraduate degree in Physiotherapy.
- Experience working as a musculoskeletal physiotherapist.
- Advanced trauma management and emergency care accreditation (or willingness to complete).
- Proven high standards of professional and personal integrity working within a pressurised environment.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, connecting with professional players, senior management and wider medical teams and provide sensitive information effectively and professionally.
- Full driving licence and access to a vehicle.
- Willingness to undergo a Disclosure & Barring Service (DBS) check.

Desirable

- Experience working within a high-performance or elite sport setting with an understanding of the unique skills required.
- Experience working with youth athletes and/or female athletes.

Hours of Work

Working hours are varied and there is an expectation that the role holder can be present for some evenings, weekends and bank holidays to meet the needs of the cricket schedule. The demands of this schedule are seasonal and will therefore fluctuate throughout the year.
